NOTICE OF PROPERTY TAX INCREASE

Fayette County has tentatively adopted a millage rate which will require an increase in property taxes by 5.30%.

All concerned citizens are invited to the public hearing on this tax increase to be held at Fayette County Administrative Complex Commission Chambers, 140 Stonewall Avenue West in Fayetteville on August 15, 2019 at 10:00 am and 5:00 pm.

Times and places of additional public hearings on this tax increase are at Fayette County Administrative Complex Commission Chambers, 140 Stonewall Avenue West, Fayetteville on d August 22, 2019 at 6:30 pm.

This tentative increase will result in a millage rate of 4.392 mills, an increase of 0.221 mills. Without this tentative tax increase, the millage rate will be no more than 4.171 mills. The proposed tax increase for a home with a fair market value of \$250,000 is approximately \$22.10 and the proposed tax increase for nonhomestead property with a fair market value of \$275,000 is approximately \$24.31.
