Shall a special 1 percent sales and use tax be reimposed in the special district of Fayette County for a period of time not to exceed 24 calendar quarters and for the raising of an estimated amount of \$136,000,000 for the following purposes pursuant to an Intergovernmental Sales Tax Agreement, dated as of August 13, 2009, among Fayette County, Georgia (the "County"), the City of Brooks, Georgia ("Brooks"), the City of Fayetteville, Georgia ("Fayetteville"), the City of Peachtree City, Georgia, ("Peachtree City"), the Town of Tyrone, Georgia ("Tyrone"), and the Town of Woolsey, Georgia ("Woolsey"); (a) Level One Countywide Projects to be owned or operated or both by the County: (1) Justice Center acquisition (currently under lease/purchase agreement); (b) Level Two Countywide Projects to be owned or operated or both by the County: (1) Emergency Operations Center; (2) University Campus; (3) Road, street, and bridge purposes: new road construction; (c) Projects to be owned or operated or both by the County in the unincorporated areas of the County: (1) Replace Tyrone and Fayetteville Fire Stations; (2) Road, street, and bridge purposes: safety and operational improvements related to arterial and collector streets, including, but not limited to New Hope Road, Lee's Mill Road, Kenwood Road, Tyrone Road, Sandy Creek Road, Hood Road, and Westbridge Road; (3) Road, street, and bridge purposes: Intersection renovation and improvement including, but not limited to, Ellison Road at Jenkins Road, Dogwood Trail at Tyrone Road, Peters Road at SR 92, Goza Road at Old Greenville, Ebenezer Road at Spear Road, Redwine Road at Birkdale & Quarters Road, SR 270 at Helmer Road, Flat Creek Road at Tyrone Road, and Ellison Road at Tyrone Road; (4) Road, street, and bridge purposes: new road from SR 54 to First Manassas Millie Road; (5) Road, street, and bridge purposes: renovation and improvement of existing county roads, including, but not limited to, resurfacing, milling, patching, and shoulder enhancement; (6) Road, street, and bridge purposes: paving gravel roads; (7) Multi-use trail construction, renovation, and improvement; (8) Replacement of Public Works heavy equipment; (9) Right-of-way landscaping improvements at County borders; (d) Projects to be owned or operated or both by the City of Brooks: (1) Library building debt retirement/acquisition; (2) Road, street and bridge purposes: sidewalks; (3) Library renovation; (4) Road, street and bridge purposes: paving dirt roads; (5) downtown parking area; (e) Projects to be owned or operated or both by the City of Fayetteville: (1) Road, street, and bridge purposes, such as, but not limited to, resurfacing of city streets, bike/ped/multi-use improvements, intersection improvement projects, Church Street extension (LCI), citywide grid/connectivity projects, Ramah/Redwine roundabout, Washington and Carver Street improvements (LCI), SR 85 medians, (LCI, North 85, etc.), SR 54 medians (Hospital Area), Manassas Millie/SR 54 Connector, SR 92 connector widening (J May/Hwy 85), SR 85 streetscape (LCI), downtown greenway (LCI), entry gateways (LCI); (2) Parks and park improvements (Citywide); (3) Wall Interconnection Project; (f) Projects to be owned or operated or both by the City of Peachtree City: (1) Costs of retiring all or a portion of General Obligation Debt, including General Obligation Library Bonds, Series 2004, General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series 2003, Airport Authority Refinancing General Obligation Bonds, Series 2002, by paying or making provision for payment of the principal and interest on such bonds; (2) Road, street and bridge purposes; street resurfacing, extensions and construction; (3) Multi-Use Path Resurfacing and extensions; (4) Road, street and bridge purposes; Crosstown @ Peachtree Parkway Intersection Improvements (local match needed for TIP); (5) Road, street and bridge purposes; SR 74 South path extension (local match needed for TIP); (6) Rite-Aid multi-use path connections; (7) Rockaway Road multi-use tunnel and path connections; (8) Road, street and bridge purposes; SR 74 North multi-use bridge and path connections; (9) SR 54 East multi-use bridge and path connections; (10) Road, street and bridge purposes; corrugated metal tunnel replacements; (11) Road, street and bridge purposes; N. Peachtree Parkway shoulder erosion; (12) Acquisition of existing City Hall and existing Leech Fire Station, presently leased by the City of Peachtree City; (g) Projects to be owned or operated or both by the Town of Tyrone: (1) Road, street and bridge purposes; resurfacing, milling, patching and shoulder enhancement; (2) Road, street and bridge purposes; paving gravel roads; (3) Miscellaneous path extensions; (4) Road, street and bridge purposes; intersection improvement projects; (5) Road, street and bridge purposes; new road alignments; (h) Projects to be owned or operated or both by the Town of Woolsey: (1) Community Center/Town Hall acquisition, improvements and furnishings?"
