Employee Assistance Plan

Our Employee Assistance Program is administered thru Once Source Counseling and Employee Assistance Services and provides you and your family 24 hour access to a professional counselor, two convenient counseling locations, referral to community resources if necessary, and follow up services for individuals who suffer from problems which currently impair or have the potential to impair productivity.

Counselors provide assessments, referrals, and short term counseling for:

- Depression
- Financial
- Child Abuse
- Marital Conflict
- Stress
- Alcohol/Drug Abuse
- Domestic Violence
- Grief
- Child Behavior
- Emotional
- Work related concerns
- Other services including assistance with implementation of alcohol and drug training, workplace violence, managerial consultation, critical incident stress debriefing, reintegration of recovering employees into the workplace, and training to recognize early warning signs of a troubled employee.
