

DOGWOOD TRAIL ROAD CLOSURE

Fayette County, Georgia, August 30, 2019- Dogwood Trail is currently **CLOSED to ALL THROUGH TRAFFIC between SR 74 and Tyrone Road** for the construction of two culvert replacement projects. The first is a Town of Tyrone culvert replacement project located between SR 74 and Crabapple Lane. The second is a Fayette County 2017 SPLOST project located between Crabapple Lane and Ellison Road. Tyrone and Fayette County have worked together to overlap the projects as much as possible to minimize impacts to the travelling public.

The County's project is replacing two, 120-inch diameter metal pipes with a 48-ft bottomless arch system. The existing pipes were failing (i.e., collapsing) due to corrosion and scour along the pipe bottoms. The Contractor mobilized and established the work zone on the afternoon of August 30, 2019, and thus extended the road closure area beyond the existing Tyrone project (see attached detour map).

The County project will take approximately six months to complete, but the schedule is dependent upon the relocation of several utilities. Once the utilities are moved, we will establish a project completion date.

Access will be maintained to all properties along Dogwood Trail throughout the life of the project.
