

Graves Road Culvert Replacement - Update

Fayette County, Georgia – May 9, 2019 – Graves Road is currently closed to thru traffic between Veterans Parkway and Ginger Cake Road for a SPLOST stormwater pipe replacement project. The road was closed on December 28th, 2018 due to a wash out around the pipe culvert.

Utility relocation is currently underway. A new power pole was installed in April, and two of the three connected utility companies have transferred their lines to the new pole. The remaining aerial utility and two underground utility relocations are scheduled to be complete by June 2019. Once all utilities are relocated, the pipe demolition and culvert installation will begin. Graves Road is scheduled to re-open to traffic in late June 2019, weather permitting.
