Old Business:

- County Parks Field Reservations
 - The Recreation Commission reviewed and accepted the revised parks and recreation usage and reservation guidelines as proposed by Anita

New Business:

- Bryan Melton from Southern Regional Hospital addresses the Recreation Commission and introduces a support program and special services offered by Southern Regional Hospital
 - The programs and services include clinics on safety and first aid, healthy and active lifestyle programs, and instructional material
- Anita reviews Fayette County recreation and participation and programs
 - Participation numbers are steady
 - Senior Programs are becoming more popular and participation in the programs is increasing

Association and Town Reports:

- All county recreation associations with representatives present, give a brief overview of the program, it's participation numbers and 2006 requests. Anita has summarized all requests from the associations and provided the summary to the Recreation Commission.
- General comments from association representatives indicate that services provided by the Recreation Department are improving and that the condition of all the parks and recreation facilities are also improving

Miscellaneous

- Kenwood Park update
 - Public works has started the rough grading on the part and progressing as weather permits.
 - Phase 1 project manager has been identified
- Kelly Park
 - Status of the building on the property is under review
 - Construction start date is still unknown.
