- SCORP
  - Anita provides the Recreation Commission with a handout summarizing the on line survey results

### New Business:

- Fayette County Parks and Recreation annual retreat
  - County Associations will be asked to attend and present a summary of 2006 and plans for 2007 on February 13, 2007
  - Recreation Commission to review and prioritize M&O and capital improvement requests and ensure linkage to the county's master plan

### Miscellaneous

- FCP&R budget due this month
  - Anita is requesting an increase in headcount of 2 to handle Kenwood Park needs and an additional Athletic Coordinator
- Participation reports are required per the association/county contract and are coming in slowly
- Recreation Commissioners recommend reviewing the role of this commission with the new county commission chairman, Jack Smith. Billy Gunnin to prepare and submit the request.
- John Feldt and Pete Nelms to prepare a sever weather training program to be offered in March to the county recreation associations
- Special Event – “Movies in the Park”
  - FCP&R to put on the events one night each in 3 different parks
  - Sponsors are needed to help fund the events
