
## AIR RIFLE SAFETY COURSE

## REFUSE TO BE A VICTIM

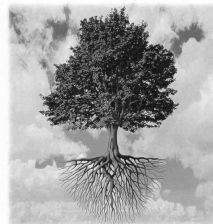

A certification card will be available within a week after you take the class.
