1. Call the meeting to order.

Commissioner Brown called the April 27, 2015 Public Arts Committee meeting to order at approximately 7:04 p.m.

2. Approval of minutes for March 30, 2015 meeting.

5. Craft Art Cooperative effort

She mentioned how the page has really received a great response. The committee discussed other ideas on how to create a webpage that would foster this concept.

6. Create Local Art Awards with various categories

The categories created were as follows: Educator, High School, Patron, Civic and Performing Art. A criteria will be created for each category and the discussion will continue at the next meeting.
