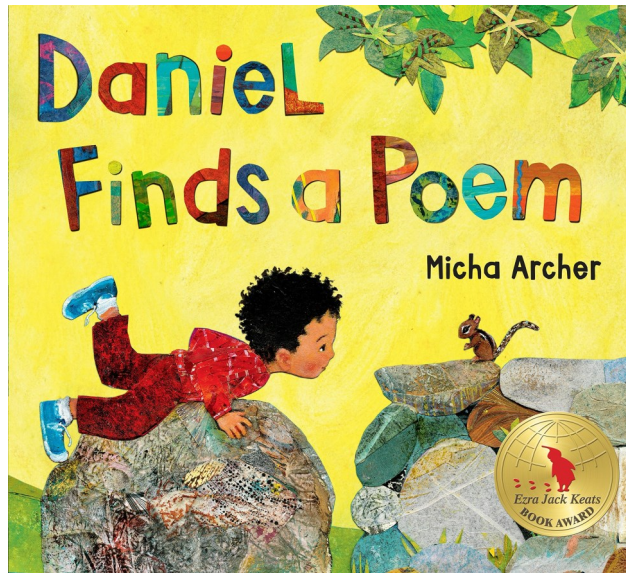




Picture Book Walk 2018 September 22-October 20
