You won't want to miss our weekly time of songs, stories, and activities designed especially for two year olds to share with their caregiver. (Children must have already turned two to attend this program.)

This program focuses on the unique developmental needs of this age group focusing on building simple vocabulary (directional words, body parts, familiar animals, etc.), counting, colors, shapes, rhymes and learning to listen and respond to simple stories. After each session, there will be a time for play to build social as well as fine and gross motor skills.

Both programs will be identical, choose **one** time slot each week.
