

Family Book Club

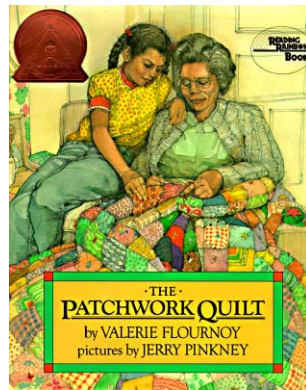
