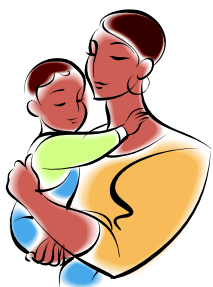
What: Sing and Play with Stories

Who: Ages 0 – 5 years

When: Mondays at 10:00 a.m.

Where: Children's Department

These fun-filled 25-minute sessions will include singing, dancing, stories, and rhymes for young children led by our children's librarian. Each week we will share a different children's story and play a different musical instrument. There is a time for crafts and enrichment play following each session. **No pre-registration required.**



What: Time for Twos

Who: 25-36 months

When: Tuesdays at 10:00 a.m.

Where: Children's Department

This program includes songs, stories, and finger plays in a toddler-friendly setting. All the fun and music of baby time, mixed with an increased focus on simple stories and basic learning concepts like colors and numbers. Simple crafts or games will also be included! **No pre-registration required.**

What: Preschool Story Time

Who: Ages 3—5 years

When: Tuesdays at 11:00 a.m.

Children 3-5 years of age are invited to this special story time filled with lively stories, music, and preschool-friendly craft projects and games. **No pre-registration required.**

What: Baby Time

Who: Ages 0—24 months

When: Wednesdays at 10:00 a.m.

Where: Large Meeting Room

Baby Time is our program for babies ages 0 to 24 months and their caregivers. This interactive program includes play time with toys, songs, stories, and finger plays. **No pre-registration required.**



What: Baby Dayz

Who: Parents of babies and toddlers

When: Second Tuesday of the month at 10:00 a.m.
