What: Celebrate with Stories
Who: Kindergarten - 5th graders
When: Thursdays at 4:00 p.m.
Where: Children's Department

Each week children ages Kindergarten and older will share a story and celebrate it with music, art, games or other activity. Come along with us as we journey to discover ourselves and our world, celebrating all of its wonders and people!

What: Family Story Time
Who: Parents and children of all ages (Activities and stories will be most geared to children ages 3—8)
When: One Saturday per month at 10:00 a.m. (See monthly calendar for specific dates)
Where: Children's Department

Come for stories, songs, rhymes followed by arts and crafts related to the stories. **No pre-registration required.**

What: Reading Quest Book Club
Who: 2nd—3rd graders
When: Once a month. Check our monthly calendar for dates, times and book titles
Where: Library small meeting room

We discuss our monthly book, engage in related activities like games or crafts and share a snack.

Pre-registration is required for each monthly meeting you wish to attend. Please sign up at least one week before the club meeting.

What: Page Turners Book Club
Who: 4th—6th graders
When: Once a month. Check monthly calendar for dates, times and book titles
Where: Library small meeting room

We discuss our monthly book, engage in related activities like games or crafts and share a snack.

Pre-registration is required for each monthly meeting you wish to attend. Please sign up at least one week before the club meeting.



What: Reading Paws (Come Read to Felix and Leo)
Who: Beginning Readers through age 11
When: Check monthly calendar for dates and times
Where: Children's department

Give your child the chance to read out loud to our Reading Dog (Leo) or Reading Cat (Felix). Reading Paws is a volunteer organization that brings animals and trained volunteers to schools and libraries to support children and parents in the reading journey. **Pre-registration is required for this program. We fill up fast! Check our monthly calendar for dates and times.**

Children may attend most of the programs on this side of the flyer independently, but parents must remain in the children's department during the program if they are under the age of 9. No unaccompanied children allowed in our Family Story Time program.
