Age-Specific Programs

(Registration is not required for our programs)

Baby Time: Wednesdays at 10 a.m.

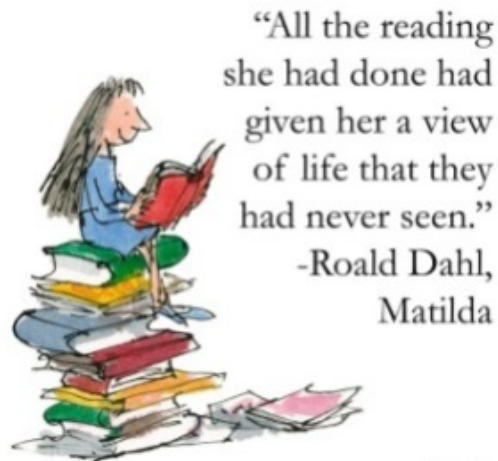
Baby-friendly play time followed by songs, rhymes, puppets, stories and interactive fun for children **ages 0-2**.

Time for Twos: Tuesdays at 10 and 11 a.m.

Songs, rhymes, puppets, stories and interactive fun for children **ages 2-3** followed by a time for play and socialization with art, games and other toddler-friendly play.

Treasure Time: Wednesdays 11 a.m.

Children ages **3-1st grade** explore the treasures we find in books mixed with songs, poetry, puppets, science and social learning. Our program is followed by a time for play and socialization with art, games, literacy and learning kits, STEM explorations, and more.

Guidelines for Age-Specific Programs

The goal for our age-specific programs is to provide a developmentally-appropriate space for children. We understand that this can be challenging with children of multiple ages in the family so we have intentionally created multi-age programs and as flexible as possible guidelines to help meet your family's needs and our program goals.

- Babies in a carrier, stroller or on a lap can attend Time for Twos or Treasure Time as long as they are attending with a child who is the right age for the program. However, be sure to also check out Baby Time and Sing and Play which are both programs that include babies! Sing and Play is a multi-age program that all ages can enjoy together.
- Active (not in a carrier or on a lap) younger siblings cannot attend our age-specific programs, but check out our family and multi-age programs for options where all ages can attend together.
- Older siblings may attend our age-specific programs as long as they are not disruptive.
*Most of our programs require an adult to attend with the child. Programs with an asterisk are geared for children to attend independently. Younger siblings cannot attend these programs. Parents should remain in the library during the program.

Baby Dayzz: Parents of babies 0-12 months are invited to join Piedmont Hospital for an informative program. **Second Tuesday of the month from 10:00 a.m.**

CAREing Paws: Practice your reading skills by signing up to read with MOOSE. See calendar for dates and times. (Ages 6 and up)

Family and Multi-Age Programs

Sing and Play with Stories: Mondays at 9:30 and 11 a.m. for ages 0-5

This is a lively program that builds early literacy skills through music, rhymes and interactive fun. Program is followed by a time of play with activities for all ages 0-5.

Friday STEAM – One Friday each month at 10 a.m. and 3:30 p.m. for ages 3 and older

This program will feature a time of book-sharing with the librarian to explore a topic or idea related to science, technology, engineering, arts or math. After the time of sharing, there will be an hour for caregiver/child exploration of stations related to the topic. While this program is for 3 and older, we will have out a small number of toys for our younger friends to enjoy with their caregivers.

Family Book Club: (Once a month) – Thursday: 7-8 p.m.

Check out this month's family read and come to our book club to enjoy art, games or other activities related to the book.

Pajama Story Time: (Once a month) – Thursday: 7 – 7:30 p.m.

Wear your favorite PJ's and come enjoy stories and more with your librarian.
