Gentlemen/Ladies:

Below, please find responses to questions, clarification, or additional information for the above referenced Invitation to Bid. You will need to consider this information when preparing your bid.

1) Is the Building that is referenced in the plans on page C-505 a part of this bid? Just making sure that was for reference only and the building is not a part of this project.

Correct. The building shown on C-505 is not included in the scope of this bid.

2) Are there any details as far as what type material the 20,000 gallon cistern is to be made of? Please refer to the plans and manufacturer details on the plans. See scope clarifications, p. 17 of the ITB.

3) Are there any liquidated damages associated with this project?

There are no liquidated damages.

4) What is the duration of this project?

Contractors shall submit a project schedule as part of their bid. The Checklist of Documents to return has been updated and is attached (Attachment 1).

5) When do you anticipate this project breaking ground?

First guarter of 2023.

6) With this being an old golf course, we assume there will be some unsuitable dirt on site. How will that be paid for if encountered?

There is a project contingency held by the County for unsuitable soil.

7) Will there be a line item added for sidewalks?

No – sidewalks shown on C-200 to the training building are not included in this scope of work.

8) Will there be a line item added for Trash Enclosure and Concrete Pad?

No – the dumpster enclosure and pad are not included in this scope of work.

9) Doesn't the City or County usually come up with the dollar amount for Allowances? There is an allowance on the bid form.

10) Will there be a line item added for signage?

No signage is required as part of this scope of work.

**11)** Where is the guardrail to be installed and can you please provide a detail for that? Please see the Tactical Driving Course plans and C-500 for the guardrail detail.

12) Will there be a line item added for 6" HDPE, Nyloplast Structures and or Roof Drain Connections? "Secondary Drainage"?

Roof Drain connects are not in the scope of this project. However, the 6" Truck Wash Drain System is included in the alternates.

13) The invitation to bid says Tactical Driving Course and Fire Training Ground. On your website under that bid you only have Fire and EMS Training Facility to be downloaded. Is the description incorrect or will you be loading another set of plans?

The plans for the tactical driving course are on the website under #2165-B Attachment 1 Project Plan Set – Part 2.

- 14) Is the Part 2 (Referenced in Questions 13) of the plan set going to be bid as a separate project?

  No. Part 2 only references that there is a second set of plans for this project.
- 15) Will Fayette County be providing a bid bond form to use or should we just use a Standard AIA Bid Bond Form?

Use the standard AIA bid bond form.

16) The plan sheets are not labeled correctly, and the contours are not aligned.

Please see the updated plan sheets (Attachment 2) which have been updated to reflect the corrected contours.

17) Can we come out at anytime to see the site?

No. This is a secured site, and no more site visits are available.

18) Should we need dirt, is it available on site?

Yes - there is fill dirt available on the site.

19) Can we waste dirt on site?

Yes – dirt can be wasted in agreed locations on site.

20) There is a GA Power easement which needs to be considered in your bid.

See Plan C-302 for location.

21) Dirt moved to the Fire Training location needs to be moved only on the old asphalt.

The new access road shall not be crossed by heavy machinery when bringing the fill dirt required for the Fire Training building.

22) What is the hauling route for bringing in asphalt and GAB?

Via Hewell Road or Corinth Road.

23) Can we burn the tree debris?

No – tree debris can be mulched and left in agreed places on site.

- 24) Is it possible that there is a section of roadway missing between sheets C-300 and C-301? Yes. Please see revised sheets C-300, C-301, C-302.
- 25) Would Fayette County consider changing the headwalls to flared end sections? Flared ends are more common on the roadways and would be safer should a car leave the track.

Please include headwalls as per the plans for the bid. Value engineering options will be considered with the selected contractor.

26) Would there be any way to get a CAD filed for this project for both parts?

CAD files will be released to awarded vendor after the Notice to Proceed is issued.



THE DESIGN PROFESSIONAL SHALL DETERMINE IF THESE BMP'S HAVE BEEN INSTALLED AND ARE BEING MAINTAINED AS DESIGNED. THE DESIGN PROFESSIONAL SHALL REPORT THE RESULTS OF THE INSPECTION TO THE PRIMARY PERMITTEE WITHIN SEVEN (7) DAYS AND THE PERMITEE MUST CORRECT ALL DEFICIENCIES WITHIN TWO (2) BUSINESS DAYS OF RECEIPT OF THE INSPECTION REPORT FROM THE DESIGN PROFESSIONAL UNLESS WEATHER RELATED SITE CONDITIONS ARE SUCH THAT ADDITIONAL TIME IS REQUIRED


