Dear Gentlemen/Ladies:

Included herein is additional information and clarification for the above referenced invitation for bid. Please consider all of this information when preparing your proposal.

- 1. Is it the County's intent that the proposed radios will be fully operational on both the 4.1 and P25 system platforms? Yes.**
- 2. Could Fayette County identify which other county systems they want programmed into their radios as part of the initial programming setup? Clayton, Coweta, Spalding, Fulton, Fairburn (On the Fulton System).**
- 3. AES is the encryption used by the other jurisdictions adjacent to Fayette County (Fulton County, Clayton County and City of Atlanta). Advanced Encryption Standard, AES, has proven to be more secure than DES and has become the Federal encryption standard and the APCO Project 25 standard. For reasons of interoperability and future system security could Fayette County consider changing this requirement from DES to AES?**
As listed in the invitation for bids, section B: Bidders may submit Cost differential for AES encryption algorithms. The county may choose to include any, all, or none of the alternates, at the county's discretion.
