



# Frequently Asked **PAINT** Questions

## 1. What paint is accepted?

- Latex Paint
- Alkyd Paint
- Acrylic Paint
- Stains
- Spray Paint
- Drywall/Joint Compound
- Pints, Quarts, Gallons, 5 Gallon Buckets

## 2. What paint is not accepted?

- Lacquer
- Thinners
- Acid Stain
- Lubricants
- Leaking Paint Cans
- Containers without Labels

## 3. They're not full gallons. Does that still cost the same?

Yes, all prices are set with the understanding that your paint can is probably not full. Keep in mind that 100 full paint cans take up as much space as 100 empty paint cans and each can must be transported and then processed individually.

## 4. Can I just mix them all together?

No! If your paint is mixed with anything, including other paint then it is no longer recyclable and will not be accepted.

## 5. My paint is already mixed, what should I do now?

According to the state of Georgia you may mix it with cat litter or other absorbent material. Once it is 100% solid, you may dispose of it in your garbage.

## 6. How do you recycle paint?

When the paint storage area is full Waste Management will take it to the paint recycling center in Atlanta where they collect and re-process paint for use again.
