Call to Order by Chairman Randy Ognio

Chairman Ognio called the November 8, 2016 Transportation Committee meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

Chairman to acknowledge that a Quorum of the Transportation Committee was present.

The presence of a quorum was acknowledged. It was noted that Mayor Laggis of the Town of Woolsey, Lt. Gary Farr of the Fayette County Sheriff office, and Jaimi Tapp of the Town of Tyrone were not present for the meeting.

MINUTES:

- 1. Approval of the October 4, 2016 Transportation Committee Meeting Minutes. Mayor Laggis, Lt Farr and Ms. Tapp were not present for the October 4, 2016 meeting.**

Ms. Robinson moved to forego the reading of the minutes. Mr. Mallon seconded the motion. The motion passed 8-0-3 with Mr. Laggis, Lt Farr and Ms. Tapp absent.

NEW BUSINESS:

2. Mr. Pete Frisina is Fayette County's Director of Planning & Zoning and is currently in the process of updating the County's Comprehensive Plan.

Mr Frisina reviewed the Fayette County's Comprehensive Plan and the relationship between land use and transportation. Mr. Frisina provided printed copies of his discussion topic to the committee members. The discussion lasted for approximately 33 minutes. 3. Discussion of the Atlanta Regional Commission's (ARC's) project solicitation process for federal-aid transportation projects.

The committee discussed which projects that could be made ready with the SPLOST funds or Storm water funds for the next solicitation. The discussion lasted for 28 minutes.

Mrs. Ellen Walls took a few minutes to shared information on how the SPLOST committee is working hard to get information out to the committee in monthly meetings. Discussion ensued on how the SPLOST money is available but not quite available for spending up front.

4. Discussion of signs along County roads.

Chairman Ognio opened the discussion with the need for new, replacement and maintenance of signs throughout the county. The discussion lasted for 15 minutes. The committee did not make a formal motion or provide formal direction.

5. Discussion of truck routes within Fayette County and options for controlling truck/freight traffic.

Mr. Phil Mallon opened the discussion with information of calls reporting trucks traveling thru the county to access Pine Studios. The discussion lasted for 18 minutes. The committee did not make a formal motion or provide formal direction.

6. Other business, if any.
