The meeting was called to order by Chairman Chuck Watkins at 8:00 A.M.

I. APPROVAL OF MINUTES FROM THE MEETING ON FEBRUARY 27, 2002.

Tony Parrott made the motion and Vice Chairman Dr. George Patton seconded, to approve the minutes from the meeting on February 27, 2002. There was no opposition.

II. DAVID SCARBOROUGH TO DISCUSS WATER LINE EXTENSION.

This item was tabled until the next meeting.

III. CONTINUED DISCUSSION OF BUFFER AT LAKE KEDRON.

Mr. Parrott explained that a home owner had requested we take down a tree. He and Sheldon Hammond with the Extension Office went out to look at the tree. Mr. Hammond sent a memo stating the tree does not look well, but it does not weaken the overall strength of the tree. He does not think it will fall down. If it does fall, he does not think it will hit the house. Mr. Hammond recommended that the buffer be replanted in this area. Mr. Parrott agreed to send a letter to the customer and include a copy of Mr. Hammond's memo.

IV. LAKE PEACHTREE DREDGING.

Mr. Mallett reported that he has written the Peachtree City engineer a letter requesting that they expedite their decisions on Drake Field, how much of the silt they want to use, and where they want to use it; so the drawings and specifications can be completed

and the job can be bid. He did this two weeks ago and has not had any response. Mr. Parrott commented we have a timetable to follow in the dredging contract. Mr. Mallett agreed he would send another letter. The committee discussed the best time to do the dredging and the timing that this project needs to be bid. Mr. Parrott expressed concern that we will end up doing this during the summer season when the demand is higher.

The committee discussed whether areas five and six need to be dredged or just left alone. They agreed to leave it at this time.

There being no further business, Chairman Chuck Watkins adjourned the meeting at 8:30 A.M.
