Wording for the Agenda:			
Approval of the Transportation Committee's recommendation for Fayette County staff and legal counsel to prepare a No Through Truck ordinance for future consideration by the Board of Commissioners.			
Background/History/Details:			
There are five roads within the unincorporated County that have some type of BOC-approved through-truck traffic restrictions: Jenkins Road, Brogdon Road, Gingercake Road, Newton Road, and Buckeye Road. After several months of discussion, the Transportation Committee is recommending Fayette County prepare an ordinance to formally prohibit through-truck traffic on select County Roads.			
Although additional roads may be added in the future, in October 2021 the Committee recommended the following six roads be included in the No Through Truck ordinance: Ebenezer Church Road, Redwine Road, Hampton Road (west), Highway 85C, Lowery Road and W. McIntosh Road. Staff suggests the five existing no-truck roads also be included as part of the ordinance.			
The proposed roads were selected based on consideration of regional connectivity, public input, availability of alternative routes, and observed truck traffic patterns.			
If approved by the BOC, staff will continue work with the Transportation Committee and the County Attorney to work out details regarding signs, enforcement, etc.
