<b>February 1, 2019</b>	Last day to fix and publish qualifying fees for offices to be filled during the 2019 Election Cycle. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-131(a)(1)(A)
<b>February 19, 2019</b>	Last day for a person to register and be eligible to vote in the March Special Election and Runoff Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-224(b)(2) *February 18 <sup>th</sup> is a Federal Holiday*
<b>February 25, 2019</b>	Earliest day for a registrar to mail an absentee ballot for the March Special Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-384(a)(2)
<b>February 25, 2019</b>	Advanced (Absentee In-Person) Voting begins for March the Special Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-385(d)(1)(A)
<b>March 15, 2019</b>	Last day for a registrar to issue absentee ballots for the March Special Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-384(a)(2)
<b>April 12, 2019</b>	Last day for a registrar to issue absentee ballots for the April Special Election Runoff. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-384(a)(2)
<b>May 9, 2019</b>	Earliest day to apply for an absentee ballot for November General Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-381(a)(1)(A)
<b>May 20, 2019</b>	Last day for a person to register and be eligible to vote in the June Special Election and Runoff Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-224(b)(2)
<b>May 27, 2019</b>	Memorial Day Holiday (State is Closed)
<b>May 28, 2019</b>	Earliest day for a registrar to mail an absentee ballot for the June Special Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-384(a)(2) *May 27 <sup>th</sup> is a Federal Holiday*

<b>May 28, 2019</b>	Advanced (Absentee In-Person) Voting begins for the June Special Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-385(d)(1)(A) <b>*May 27<sup>th</sup> is a Federal Holiday*</b>
<b>June 14, 2019</b>	Last day for a registrar to issue absentee ballots for the June Special Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-384(a)(2)
<b>July 4, 2019</b>	Independence Day Holiday (State is Closed)
<b>July 12, 2019</b>	Last day for a registrar to issue absentee ballots for the July Special Election Runoff. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-384(a)(2)
<b>August 19, 2019</b>	Last day for a person to register and be eligible to vote in the September Special Election and Runoff Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-224(b)(2)
<b>August 26, 2019</b>	Earliest day for a registrar to mail an absentee ballot for the September Special Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-384(a)(2)
<b>August 26, 2019</b>	Advanced (Absentee In-Person) Voting begins for the September Special Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-385(d)(1)(A)
<b>September 13, 2019</b>	Last day for a registrar to issue absentee ballots for the September Special Election Runoff. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-384(a)(2)
<b>October 7, 2019</b>	Last day for a person to register and be eligible to vote in the November General Election and Runoff Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-224(a)
<b>October 11, 2019</b>	Last day for a registrar to issue absentee ballots for the October Special Election Runoff. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-384(a)(2)
<b>October 14, 2019</b>	Columbus Day Holiday (State is Closed)
<b>October 15, 2019</b>	Earliest day for a registrar to mail an absentee ballot for the November General/Special Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-384(a)(2)
<b>October 15, 2019</b>	Advanced (Absentee In-Person) Voting begins for the November General Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-385(d)(1)
<b>November 1, 2019</b>	Last day for a registrar to issue absentee ballots for the November General Election and Runoff Election. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-384(a)(2)
<b>As soon as possible</b>	Absentee ballots shall be mailed out as soon as possible prior to the General Election Runoff for Local and State Offices. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-384 (a)  Advanced (In-Person) Voting begins for the General Election Runoff for Local and State Offices. O.C.G.A. § 21-2-385(d)(1)

*\*O.C.G.A. § 21-2-14. When the last day for the exercise of any privilege or discharge of any duty prescribed or required by this chapter shall fall on a Saturday, Sunday, or legal holiday, the next succeeding business day shall be the last day for the exercise of such privilege or the discharge of such duty.*
