

Job Title: Road Department Equipment Operator Intern

Position Type: Internship (Summer)

Hours: Up to 40 hours per week for 10 weeks

Location: Fayette County Road Department

Overview: The Fayette County Road Department is seeking a high school student looking to gain operating construction equipment experience as an Intern for the summer. This position is ideal for individuals interested in gaining hands-on experience in Public Works in local government.

Key Responsibilities:

- Construction Equipment Operation: Learn entry level introduction to the following construction equipment: excavator, rubber tire loader, skid steer and grass tractor. This includes safety and general maintenance of each of these pieces of equipment.
- Traffic Control Certification: Will go through training to receive Traffic Control Certification for the ability to perform traffic control. Will receive a Certification Card that will be good for 2 years.
- General Labor: Provide general labor for construction crews when not learning to operate equipment.
- Additional Duties: Perform other tasks assigned to support Road Department operations.

Qualifications:

- Ability to work outside and in high temperature environments for 8+ hours daily
- Ability to stand for 8+ hours daily
- Ability to lift 10lbs+
