FAYETTEVILLE'S CHOISNET WINS "WHEEL OF FORTUNE" PRIZE

Choisnet said she dreamed of being on the show for a long time.

After applying online and submitting a virtual audition, she was accepted as a contestant.

"As soon as we got in our spots behind the wheel, my heart was pounding! That was the fastest 22 minutes of my entire life," Choisnet said.

"I practiced by playing the Wheel of Fortune App and getting tips from previous contestants. My cousin was a contestant on the show in 2006," she said.

"One strategy was to buy a vowel if I needed an extra second or two to think before solving the puzzle. I also decided ahead of time that if I made it to the Bonus Round, I would guess "o" as my vowel. If you watched the episode, you know I should have guessed 'a'!" Choisnet said.

When asked what she will do with her prize, Choisnet said she will focus on family.

"I plan to put my cash winnings in savings. I will bring my sister with me to Maui. My dad is going to join us and we're going to spread my mom's ashes at the beach, like she always wanted," Choisnet said.
