## Welcome, Invocation, and Pledge led by Charles McCollum

<u>Minutes</u>: Bryan Thompson made a motion to accept the June 2020 minutes. Lisa Mahaffey 2<sup>nd</sup> the motion. Motion passed 3-0.

#### Old Business:

**FY2020 Budget:** The FY2020 was approved and remains the same as last year - \$1.4MM. A new van will be purchased through the Vehicle Replacement Fund. The only item approved from the CIP requests was a walkway repair between McCurry Park Softball fields 1-5. All other CIP items were not approved.

#### **Re-Opening the Parks and Facilities:**

The current status has remained unchanged from two-weeks ago. Youth associations are beginning practices, fall seasons are still moving forward, youth football conditioning will start this week, and adult leagues have begun. At our last meeting, a discussion took place regarding the possible relocation of the bleachers. After further review, this is not possible. Informational stickers will be ordered for the bleachers to remind spectators to social distance, and blue painters' tape will be used to block off every other row on each bleacher. We will continue to monitor the Governor's orders should things change and need to be addressed.

#### New Business:

**Batting Cages:** A discussion took place regarding outside teams wanting to reserve and use our batting cages. This agenda item will be tabled to the next meeting in order for the full commission to be present.

**Arts Committee Recommendation:** The chairman of the Arts Committee has submitted a proposal to disband their committee due to lack of participation. The Arts Chairman suggested any future proposed art projects should be brought to the Parks and Rec Commission since it falls under the oversight of Parks and Recreation. A motion will be made if the Recreation Commission is asked for help on any art projects, the requestor will need to submit a formal proposal to the Recreation Commission.
