Minutes from the February 13, 2007 Recreation Commission meeting were approved unanimously.

## Old Business:

- Soccer - Recreation Commission recommends submitting requests as submitted with the exception of the south parking lot
- Fireworks and Weapons – Recreation Commission reviews the ordinance as prepared by the county attorney and approves the ordinance as written

## New Business:

- Partners of the Parks
  - Creating or sponsoring a volunteer organization to monitor/patrol parks to increase security and provide another method to help ensure the safety in the parks was discussed. Recreation Commission supports the idea.
- Park Gates
  - Installing gates to the county parks was discussed. The gates would restrict access and add additional protection for county property.
  - The Recreation Commission requests that the sheriff and marshal's offices provide information about any unlawful activity or property damage that may be on file
  - The recreation commission would also like to see quotes on the cost of installing gates

## Miscellaneous

- Park improvements
  - Lake Horton has added new trails and incorporated 13 new acres into the park.
  - Docks at Lake Kedron need to be rebuilt
