 - All associations will be invited to attend for the presentation

- Needs assessment
 - The RC would like to review the goals and objectives of the needs assessment
 - How often is the assessment updated and how often should it be reviewed?
 - Are the projected dollars associated with the projects adjusted over time?
 - Can the county Finance department adjust for inflation and time?

New Business:

- Weather Warning Sirens
 - Significant weather alerts are being set up
- Severe Weather Procedure
 - Heat index charts incorporated in the severe weather process
 - Four heat index meters will be purchased and put in use
 - Anita will work with the F&ES to develop guidelines around heat index for review at the next RC meeting
 - John requests that Anita email associations to raise awareness of the issue in the recreation community
