Minutes from the April 2008 Recreation Commission meetings were approved unanimously.

Old Business:

- Needs assessment
 - The Recreation Commission will prepare a letter of findings in executive summary format to submit to the County Commission.
 - The executive summary will outline the recommendations of the FCRC regarding the needs assessment.
 - The recommendations will be usage based and outline the top four items needing attention
 - Top 4: Continuing operations and improvements to existing facilities, an aquatic Center, gyms, and land acquisition
 - The final draft of the needs assessment recommendation will be submitted up approval of the executive summary letter

New Business:

- Standards of Operation Plan
 - The Recreation Commission will be to prepare a document for all Fayette County Recreation Associations to use as a guide for operations. The Recreation Commission will also review the existing Association contract for possible enhancements

Miscellaneous

- Frank met with a real estate development company – Group 6 – that was preparing a proposal for recreation complex near Peachtree
- The Recreation Commission would like Group 6 to come to the next meeting and review the proposal
