100 Books Before High School

We're challenging all 6-8th graders to read 100 books before high school! Sign up at any time and read at your own pace. There are no assigned books, no deadlines (other than finishing before you start high school!), and no reports to write. Read whatever you want, whenever you want!

At 25, 50, and 75 books, you'll be eligible to receive a free book and special bookmark. If you read 100 books before you start high school, you'll earn a High School Survival Kit, full of supplies to get you ready and excited for high school!

100 Books Before Graduation

For high schoolers in grades 9-12, the challenge is to read 100 books before graduation!

Sign up at any time and read at your own pace. You may only be able to fit in a page a night, but you'll get there!

As with your 100 Books Before High School program, at 25, 50, and 75 books you'll receive a free book and a special bookmark. If you complete your challenge, you will earn an After School Adventure Kit, packed with items that will help you in navigating your next steps after graduation.

Participants can only complete the program and earn prizes one time. Each book logged must be unique, rereads cannot be counted as two separate books.
