

Reading books and sharing stories with your children are two of the best ways to help them enter school with the language skills they need to learn and grow.

Are you ready to get started?

- Fill out a registration card and give it to Ms. Ada or Ms. Charlotte at the desk in the children's department.
- Once registered, you will receive a bag containing your reading log and everything you need to get started...plus a few goodies. Be sure to check out a few books to put in the bag before you leave!
- Each time you read and record 50 books, bring your log back to the library so we can chart your progress. We'll give you a special bookmark or sticker to congratulate you on your progress! You can also pick up another log so you can keep working toward your goal.

- When your child has read 500 books, we want to celebrate their achievement by
 posting a picture of them holding one of their favorite books on our Facebook page
 and in a special place in our children's department.
- When your child has reached their goal of 1,000 books, it's time to celebrate! They'll
 receive a free book from the library and an invitation to our celebration program. At
 the program, each child that has completed 1000 Books Before Kindergarten will be
 recognized and presented with a completion certificate.

Most children love repetition, so you can count the same book or story multiple times!

Keep track of all the books that your child reads or that someone reads to your child. Include stories that your child hears at the library, in preschool, or daycare.
