**Subject: Invitation to Bid #1943-B: SPRING RESURFACING
Addendum 1**

Gentlemen/Ladies:

Below, please find responses to questions, a **new pricing sheet** and estimated road quantities for the above referenced Invitation to Bid. You will need to consider this information when preparing your bid.

- 1) Can Fayette Co. provided the bidding contractors with a Resurfacing Breakdown of the work being performed on each road? See Attachment #1
- 2) Is the 2,833.60 tons of 19mm to be used for the Patching? YES
- 3) If the 19mm item is used for the Patching would Fayette Co. consider changing the item to 2,833.60 tons of Patching, which would include the milling removal & 19mm material together? YES the bid sheet quantities has been changed to reflect this. **Please use Attachment #2 Pricing Sheet instead of the one included in the original Invitation To Bid.**
- 4) Will the areas marked for Patching be 7' or wider so a milling machine can be used? YES our inspector will mark areas to be a minimum of 7'
- 5) What are the depths of the 9.5mm TP2, 12.5mm, 19mm and 9.5mm OGI?
9.5mm TP2 – 165 lbs/sy
12.5mm – 220 lbs/sy
19mm – 220 lbs/sy
9.5mm OGI – 110 lbs/sy
- 6) There are (9) roads identified on the Road List for Milling. What type milling will be performed on these (9) roads – Full Width or Edge Milling? Edge milling on the following roads: Galway Bend, Healy Pass, Glen Beigh Run, Westmeath Path, Roscommon Court, Shelburn Run, Galic Way (on all Cul-de-sacs will be fully milled)
- 7) Will a MTV (Shuttle Buggy) be required in placing the 12.5mm asphalt mix? MTV is not required but encouraged
- 8) Will the contractor be required to post mount the advanced warning signs or can these signs be placed on tripod stands? Tripods due to the short nature of these resurfacing projects
- 9) Will the contractor be required to supply any compaction test on this project? We are requiring that the Contractor is performing all required material testing at the plant to make sure the materials meet GDOT specifications. COUNTY will have testing firm on-site in the field to do testing on materials once they are placed.
- 10) Please clarify the State Warranty Coverage (3 year Minimum). Generally on a resurfacing project the warranty is (1) year. Fayette County will require the construction standard of 1 year.

- 11) Will the contractor be required to mill and pave into side roads? Yes, the only side roads is on Veteran's Pkwy all the other side roads are on the list included in the Gaelic Subdivision.
- 12) Will any shoulder building, grassing, installing barrels and installing Low/Soft Shoulder Signs be required on this project? No shoulder building on this project.
- 13) Can Fayette Co. supply the paving limits on each of the (14) roads?
- Carriage Drive – SR 314 to Cul-de-sac
 - Gaelic Way – Jenkins Road to Cul-de-sac
 - Galway Bend – Gaelic Way to Cul-de-sac
 - Glen Beigh Run – Gaelic Way to Cul-de-sac
 - Healey Pass – Gaelic Way to Galway Bend
 - Inman Road – S. Jeff Davis Dr to SR 92
 - Lee's Lake Road – Lee's Mill Road to County Line
 - Lucy Place – Quarters Road to Cul-de-sac
 - Old Farm Road – SR 92 to Cul-de-sac
 - Roscommon Court – Gaelic Way to Cul-de-sac
 - Shelbourne Run – Gaelic Way to Cul-de-sac
 - Veteran's Pkwy – S. Sandy Creek Road to Hood Road
 - Weldon Road – Inman Road to Hillsbridge Road
 - Westmeath Pass – Ellison Road to Gaelic Way


