Subject: Request for Quote #2002-A: Crack Sealing Services

When asphalt cracks, water can penetrate the road surface, leading to pavement failures and more extensive repairs. Sand, dirt, and other non-compressible substances can also enter the crack, leading to pavement upheaval. If cracks are sealed in a timely manner, it will increase the life of the road, and reduce long-term costs. To maintain the county roadway, the Road Department has identified the following five (5) roads, Ellison Road, Gingercake Road, Corinth Road, Chappell Road and Milam Road as roads that would benefit from crack sealing services.

Toward this end, the Purchasing Department issued Request for Quote (RFQ) #2002-A Crack Sealing Services. Notices of the opportunity to quote were emailed to twenty-five (25) vendors who responded to other solicitations for road repairs and through internet searches. The RFQ was also advertised on the Georgia Procurement Registry, and the Local Government Access Marketplace websites.

The Purchasing Department received five (5) quotes (Attachment 1). The Road Department recommends award to the low responder, Blount Construction Company, Inc. a Contractor Performance Evaluation is attached (Attachment 2).


